Other: Healed nasal fracture with significant distortion to the left side of the nose.

Clothing: A dark blue leg warmer was found near the site of discovery.

Circumstances: On July 31, 1997 the skeletal remains of an unknown woman were found in the Ada Township Park located at 9232 E.. Fulton St. It is believed that the remains had been at this site a year or longer before being discovered.
